# Successful Impact of CHNA is WHEN ??

- ▶ Community health improvement efforts are most successful when they are grounded in “collective impact,” where “highly structured collaborative efforts” yield “substantial impact on social problem.
- ▶ Collective impact focuses on cooperation, collaboration, and partnership to help achieve common priorities and inform partners’ investment strategies.

A successful CHNA draws diversity in thoughts and perspectives which will naturally link to each other for ideas

# JONATHON RECOMMENDATION

## Community Health Needs Assessment Data

- ▶ **Housing Recommendation:** The Village Council could meet with local realtors annually to discuss the trends and barriers that exist for families attempting to move into the village. Affordable housing units versus contemporary commercial properties both face challenges due to the lack of available land in the village. This could be mitigated if Antioch College and/or Antioch University are willing to cooperate with village stakeholders to fashion existing parcels of land into residential housing developments.
- ▶ **Environment Recommendation:** It is recommended that the village water supply be fluoridated to optimal levels in order to establish preventive measures against tooth decay. The Village Council could consider a call to action regarding fluoridation of Yellow Springs' water supply in order to solicit public opinion. Ideally the council would be able to receive popular opinions, whether they be for or against fluoridation of the water supply, and put the issue to public vote.
