

**VILLAGE OF YELLOW SPRINGS, OHIO  
RESOLUTION 2021-52**

**RECOGNIZING THE RETIREMENT OF CHIEF BRIAN CARLSON FROM THE YELLOW  
SPRINGS POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, Chief Brian Carlson submitted a notice of retirement to the Village August 16, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, Chief Carlson has capably served the Yellow Springs Police Department as Chief since 2017, and prior to that as a patrol officer,

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Yellow Springs, pursuant to R.C. 721.15(A), may allow the Chief to purchase his duty sidearm as an item of personal property not exceeding \$1,000.00 in value and not needed for municipal purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, Chief Carlson has requested to purchase the firearm and the Village Manager, by statute, has supervision or management of that property and may determine the duty sidearm's fair market value based on the age and condition of the handgun and its replacement value; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village must comply with the provisions of the federal Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act of 2004 (LEOSA), 18 USC § 926 B-C, which requires a retired law enforcement officer to possess a photographic identification issued by his former agency;

**NOW, THEREFORE, COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF YELLOW SPRINGS, OHIO  
HEREBY RESOLVES THAT:**

**Section 1.** The Village Manager is hereby authorized to complete the transfer documentation for fair market value sale of Chief Carlson's duty sidearm to Chief Carlson.

**Section 2.** The Village shall provide a photo ID card which identifies Chief Carlson as a retired law enforcement officer of the Yellow Springs Police Department consistent with LEOSA requirements.

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its adoption.
